Now begins your learning adventure into the world of reading through the world of art. Add silver glitter to make Percival sparkle.










This year, one of the things we will be learning is how to write our letters. With a pencil follow the maze shapes below.

Practice making the shapes of upper and lower case A by drawing within the letter outlines.











Cut a small apple in half lengthwise. Dip the cut surface of the apple into the paint and then press it against the paper. Set the prints aside to dry.



SUPPLIES: Apples (Red Delicious apples work best due to their distinct apple shape), assorted washable paints on paper plates, and damp paper towels.






























Mr. Monkey likes to play with coins people give to him. Draw a line from Mr. Monkey to the upper or lower case M coins.

Mount on card stock. Cut out along dashed lines. Color in the mask and tie a string through the holes.










