

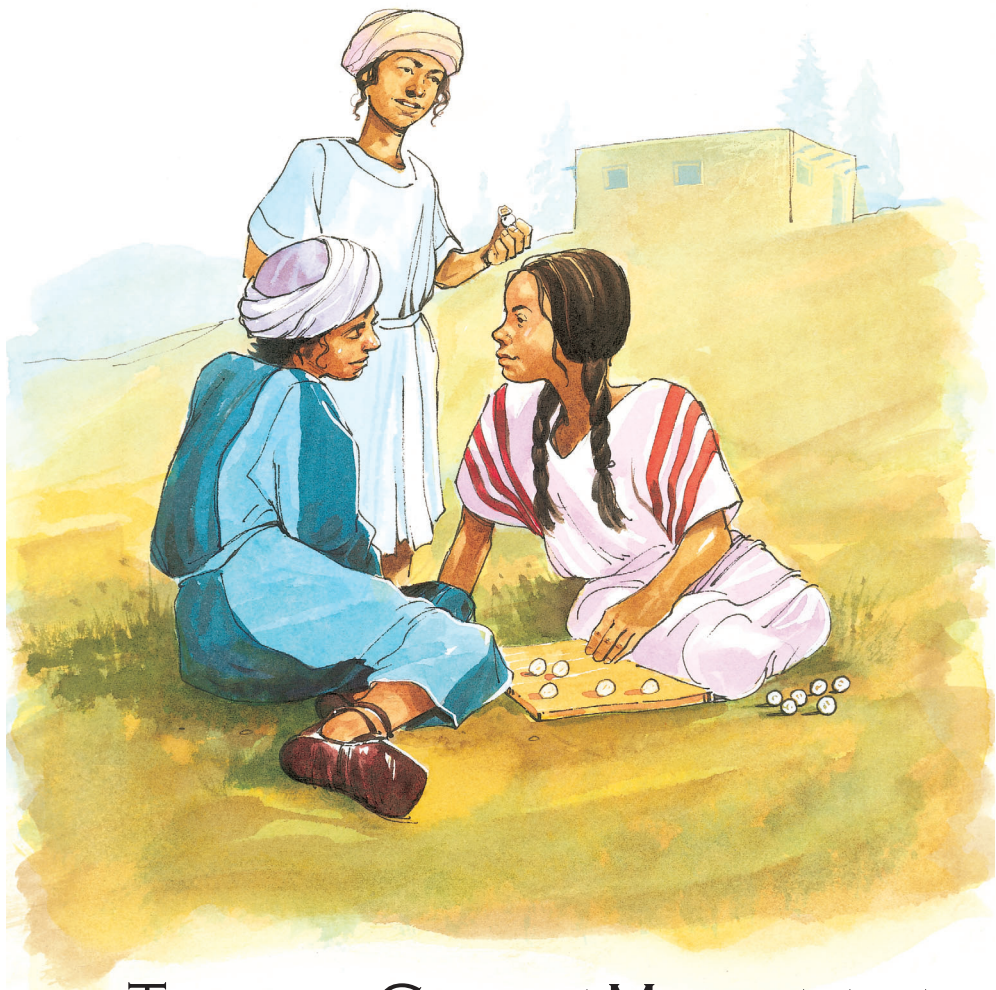

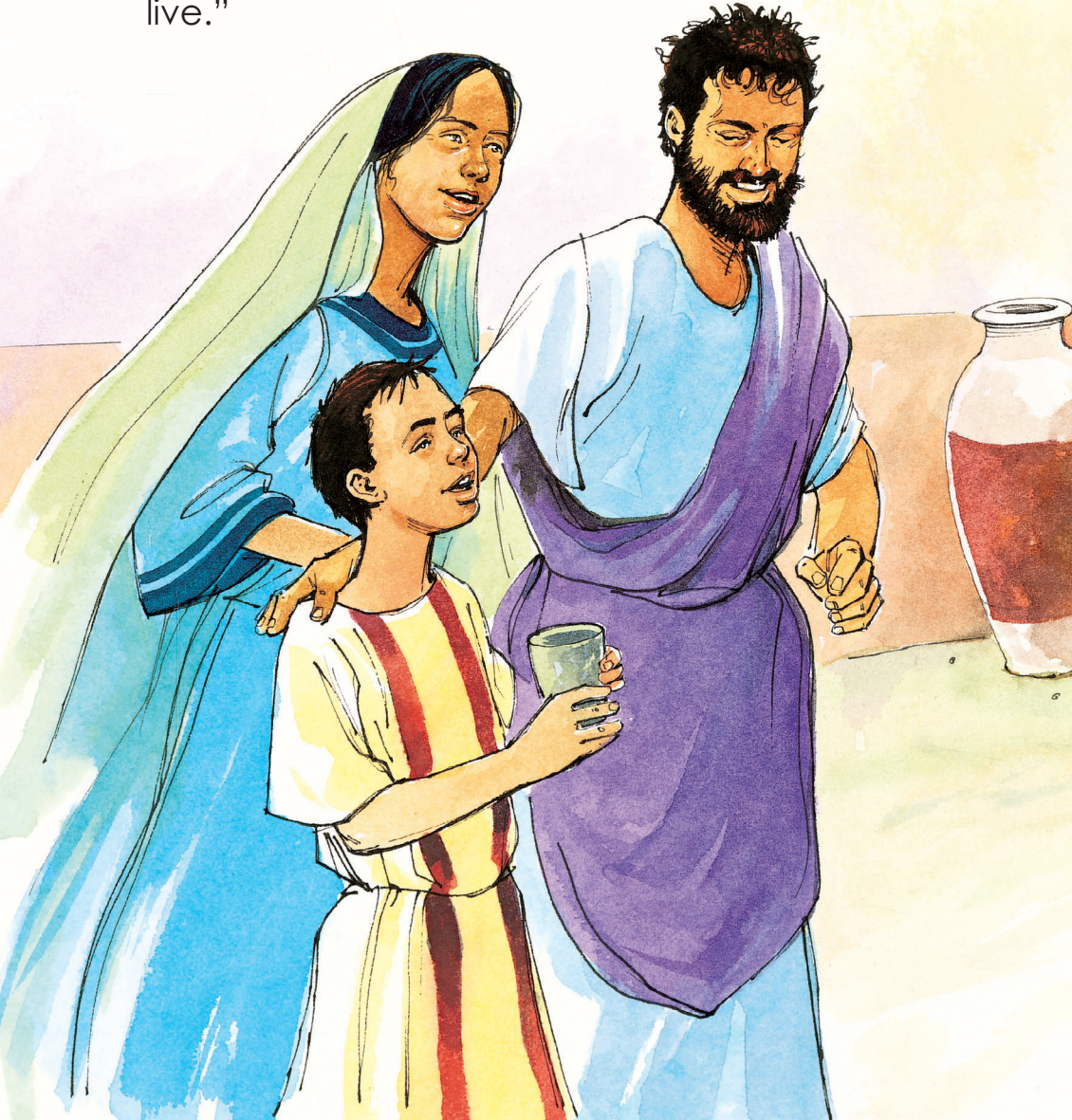

Jairus asked Jesus to come at once to heal his little girl. When Jesus reached his home, he said, "Do not be afraid, only believe."

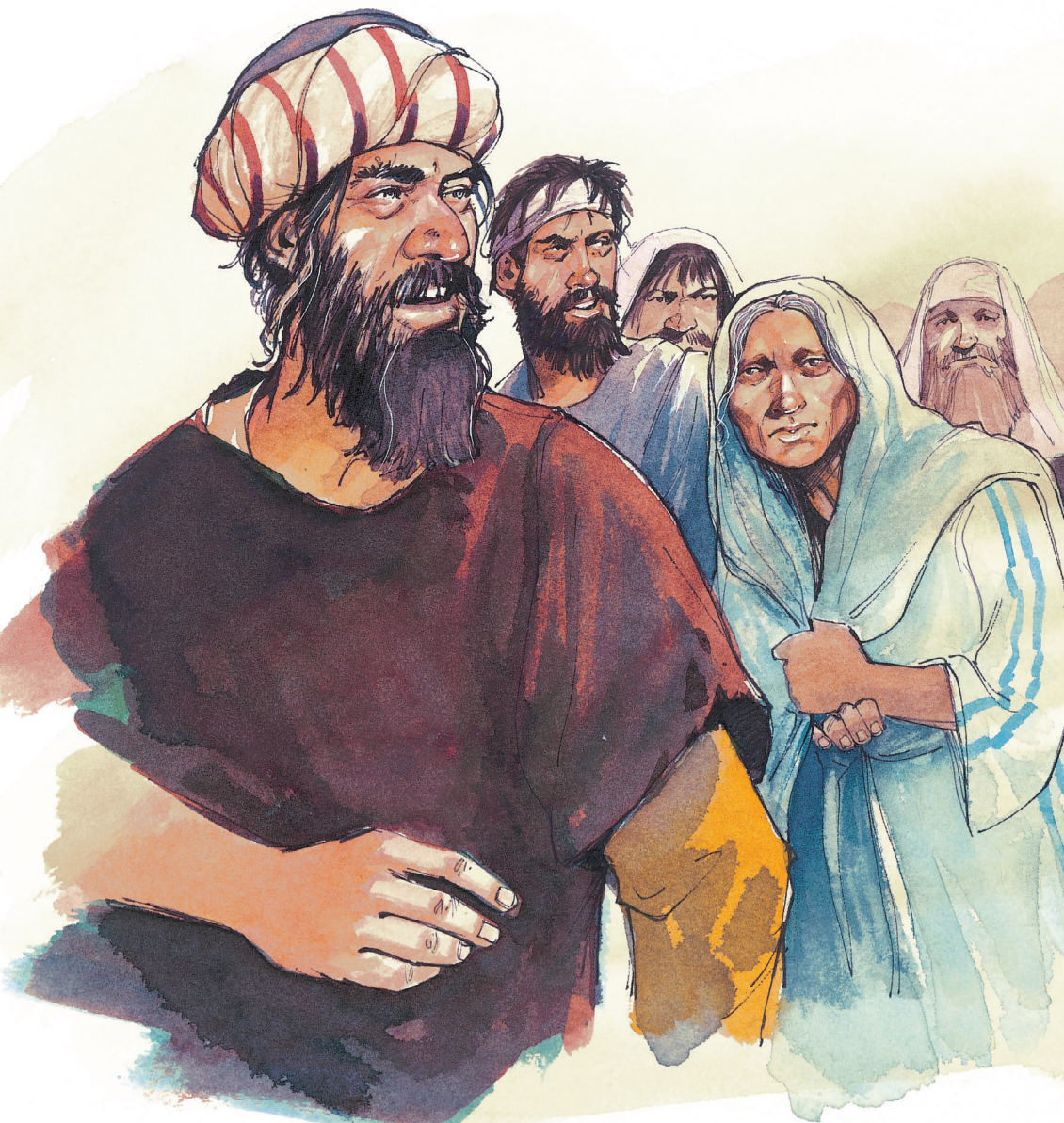




He went to the room where the girl was lying. "Little girl," he said, "get up!"
